Climbing Wall / Low COPE Course	\$20 per person (special age & group size limits)	
Shooting Sports	(all safety restrictions established by the National Council are utilized on our ranges) (must use camp equipment & ammunition, and have pre-approved certified RSO & Instructor) (\$10 charge per firearm if not cleaned after use)	
Rifles – .22 cal.	\$1.00 per 10 shots	
Shotguns – 20 ga.	\$12.50 per 25 shots (includes clays)	
Muzzleloaders – .50 cal.	\$5.00 per 10 shots	
BB Guns	\$0.50 per person (\$15.00 minimum)	
Archery	\$0.50 per person (\$15.00 minimum) \$1.50 charge per damaged or missing arrow	

Fishing in Murray Gill Lake is available for Scouting units and permitted persons only. No fishing is allowed in or near the Waterfront docks, cove, etc.

Select training events are exempt from facility fees for training and meal-related spaces used, but are liable for costs of indoor sleeping quarters if desired.
