- Activities?** This year’s Spring Camporee is for all Troops, Crews, and Posts, *all Districts welcome*. This year’s theme is “No School like Old School”. The day will be filled with Patrol Competitions. Each patrol in your Unit will participate individually, so we will need to know how many patrols you’re bringing. There will also be an award ceremony at the end of the day and later a Camp-Wide game of Capture the Flag! Competition for best vintage uniform and best hiking staff will be awarded. So, grab that old Scout book your Grandpa had and dust it off.... You’ll need it! **Units will provide their own food & cook by patrol method.**
- When & Where?** The Camporee will be held on the west side of Lake Afton again this year. Official check in will begin at 5:30 pm on Friday April 26th, but camping spots are available on a first come, first serve basis prior to check-in. Any campsite reserved or used prior to **Friday April 19** will have to pay the normal camping fees of Lake Afton. Activities will begin on Saturday morning at 8:30am.
- Supervision?** All units must have two-deep leadership in accordance with Youth Protection Guidelines, and all registered leaders must have completed NEW Youth Protection Training.
- Cost?** **Registration Fee is \$8 per Scout / \$5 per Adult.**
LATE fees of \$14 scout/ \$10 adult will apply after **April 8, 2019.**
Last day to register online is Tues., April 23, 2019.
- Refunds?** Refunds are not available but may be transferred to another Scout or Adult.
- Registration?** Registration *OPENS DEC. 1, 2018*, online under *DISTRICT CAMPOREES* on *Tentaroo. Pre-registration is required in order for program materials and patches to be provided to all participants. **Registration prior to April 8th is required to guarantee a patch.** Event is open to all registered Troops, Crews and Posts. Please register at <https://quivira.tentaroo.com>. **Online payment is required** and may be made by credit card or electronic check. Parts A & B of the health forms are required and must be turned in for all participants at check in. Forms will not be provided onsite.
- Insurance?** Liability, Sickness and Accident Insurance are provided for all registered members of the Quivira Council.
