



# Quivira Council Century Ride

## Mar. 30, 2019 at Sedgwick County Park



Ride 100 miles as a team to celebrate  
100 years of Quivira Council

**Who:** All Quivira Packs, Troops, and Crews are invited to participate in this event, as well as their family members and the public at large. Those who are not associated with the BSA will need to sign a waiver during check-in at the event.

**What:** This activity provides an opportunity for teams of scouts and their families to ride 100 man/miles on their own bicycles as a group, in celebration of 100 years of Quivira Council. For example, a team of 10 would need to ride 10 miles together to equal 100 man/miles. The route circuit will be over the paths and roads within the park and several laps will be necessary. Scouts who do not have a team may be linked up with other scouts at the event. Completing the whole 100 man/miles as a team is not required to participate but is required to receive the commemorative patch. Participants will be responsible for bringing their own meals. Water, some refreshments, and a trading post will be available during the event, as well as access to restrooms. First aid and a bike repair station (simple flats and adjustments) will be available. Participants will receive a small "goodie bag" at checkout, and a special patch for completing the 100 miles as a team.

**Required items to bring:**

- Your own bike in good, working condition
- Your own tire patches and/or extra inner tube
- At least one mileage tracking device for each team (GPS, phone, or cycle computer)
- Legal bicycle helmets are required for each participant riding

**When:** Saturday, Mar. 30, 2019 from 7 am until 3 pm. This event will occur rain or shine.

**Where:** Sedgwick County Park, 6501 W 21st St, Wichita, KS 67205. Check in and out will be at the Sunflower Shelter near the south entrance (13th Street) of the park.

**How:** Cost is \$15 per participant. Registration via Tentaroo under "Century Bike Ride!". Register by Mar. 16, 2019. No refunds, but slots can be transferred.

**Why:** Because riding your bike is fun with your friends, and you only get to celebrate Quivira's centennial year once in your lifetime!
