Course Overview

This premier Council level co-ed training experience teaches the concepts of what a leader must **BE**, what they must **KNOW**, and what they must **DO**. These key elements bring together the **HOW TO'S** of Leadership. Your Leadership skills will come alive as you embark on your Quest for the Meaning of Leadership in one week-long course.

Your week will focus on leadership principles located in and around your camp area with excursions throughout the week.

Youth Who May Attend

- Any registered youth 14 or older or 13 and have completed the 8th grade.
- Scouts must be a First Class Scout and completed Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops (ILST).
- Venturing Scouts must have completed Crew Officers Orientation and Introduction to Leadership Skills for Crews (ILSC)
- New this year Young ladies from new Girls Troops are invited to join but must meet the age requirements and have completed ILST.
- Be recommended by their Scoutmaster or Crew Advisor.

Registration

The NYLT fee is \$185. The cut-off date for registration and final fees due is May 1, 2019. To register, submit the completed application form along with a non-refundable deposit of \$35.00 to the Quivira Council office. Participants will be accepted on a first-come first-served basis until the course reaches capacity. Alternates will be placed on a stand-by list.

The Fee covers training materials, food, and recognition items. In addition, you will need to provide your personal camping gear and uniforms. Details will be found in your participant packet located on our council's web site, www.quivira.org

Award...

NYLT participants who attend all sessions will receive the BSA NYLT patch in recognition of completing the course.

...and Application

Only those completing NYLT can earn the Quivira Council's Silver Tomahawk Award and patch. To earn the Silver Tomahawk Award, with agreement between the home unit Leader and Scout, the youth must demonstrate the leadership skills learned at NYLT; put these skills into practice at their home unit; and accomplish these goals during the six months after the course.



The Silver Tomahawk Award recognizes that the purpose of NYLT is not just to provide a great training adventure and experience for Scouts, but also to develop Leaders that serve their Units.
