Information presented and classroom activities performed will prepare the Scout to meet with a Personal Management merit badge counselor and complete several of the merit badge requirements.

However, this workshop will present information concerning requirement numbers 2, 4, 5, 6, and 7 preparing them for a productive merit badge counselor session to fulfill those requirements.**
