OPEN TO ALL CUB SCOUT PACKS, BOTH IN AND OUT OF COUNCIL

- What is it?** **Day Camp, Hosted by the Osage Nation District** is a fun-filled, two-day camp for Cub Scouts of all ages. Each day will provide a fun opportunity for your Scouts to have new experiences, with mighty adventures that will last a lifetime.
- Activities?** **Join the Scouts on this year's Exploration:** Scouts will be building crafts, participating in shooting sports activities (Archery, wrist-rockets and BB gun) and much more.
- When & Where?** **Friday & Saturday, June 7 & 8, 2019, Big Hill Lake Overlook area.** Check-in begins at 8:00 a.m. the first day of camp. Camp runs 9-4 each day.
- Health Forms?** **Parts A & B of the BSA Health Form is required for all scouts and adults.** Forms must be turned in at check in. Blank forms **will not** be provided.
- Cost?** **Regular Registration by May 6, 2019 is \$35 per Scout/participating tag-a-long** (Includes T-shirt, water bottle, patch, and draw string backpack) **\$35 per Adult.** (Includes T-shirt and patch) Participating tag-a-longs should register under their corresponding age appropriate Scout rank. Age 5 and under register as Lions.

- Food?** **Morning and afternoon snack will be provided, as well as lunch each day. If youth or adult has special dietary needs please note on the registration form.**
- Supervision?** All units must have an adult/scout ratio of 1/5 and two-deep leadership in accordance with Youth Protection Guidelines and **all adults** must have **completed Youth Protection Training prior to camp. Please bring a copy of all Adult Youth Protection certification to check-in.**
- Registration?** Event is open to all Packs, in or out of Council. Pre-registration is required in order for us to provide patches, water bottles, shirts and program materials to all youth participants as well as patches and shirts to adults. Please register online and pay all fees by the regular price deadline of **May 6th, 2019.** Registrants prior to May 6th will be \$35/youth and \$35/adults. All registrations received after May 6th will register at the late rate of \$45/youth and \$45/adults. **No registrations will be accepted after May 27th. Any persons not registered for the event will not be allowed to attend the event and will be asked to leave.** Registrations and payments for all Quivira Council events are now online and this registration is available through www.quivira.org/Camping webpage link. Once on *Tentaroo select **Day Camps** to continue. Online payment is required and can be made by credit card or electronic check (use down arrow for selection).
- Insurance?** Liability, as well as sickness and accident insurance are provided for all registered youth and adult members of Quivira Council.
- Camping?** Camping is NOT part of the Day Camp, however your Pack may organize a Family Camp at Big Hill Lake. Any camping must be in compliance with BSA camping guidelines. You may reserve a site by calling (620) 336-2741, these sites will provide you with some utilities and swimming. There is a Scout only camp site but it is a first come first serve area with no utilities.
