**OSAGE NATION FALL GATHERING**

- What is it?** Fall gathering is a two-night camping event for Cub Scouts, Webelos, Arrow of Light, Scouts BSA and Venturing youth held at Card Creek Camp on Elk City Lake west of Independence. It is intended to give Scouts an opportunity to go camping and enjoy many of the great activities and adventures they love
- Activities?** Age appropriate activities including Tri-wizards Tournament, Sorcerer Stone challenge, Whomping Willow and Quidditch. Crafts, cooking and much, much more!
- Food?** All meals will be patrol cooking and Units will need to provide their own food. Saturday evening will be a pot luck dinner.
- When & Where?** Friday, October 18 Check in begins at 6 P.M., Program Saturday all day. Checkout Sunday morning after Worship Service.
- Supervision?** Packs, Troops and Crews must have an adult/scout ratio of 1/5 and 2-deep leadership in accordance with Youth Protection Guidelines. All adults including those not registered as leaders in BSA must complete Youth Protection Training prior to camp and bring certificate. Those attending as a family at least one parent must accompany the child for the entire event.
- Cost?** Early bird Fee is \$10 per youth \$10 per Adult. Registration after October 14<sup>th</sup> will be \$15 per youth and \$15 per adult. **Please note last day to register online Wed., October 16.**
- Refunds?** Refunds are not available for this event but may be transferred to another youth or adult.
- Registration?** Pre-registration is required in order for us to provide program materials to all youth participants. Event is open to all Units, both in and out of Quivira Council. All registrations received online after October 14 will register at the regular rate of \$15/ youth and \$15 /adult. No add-ons, registrations, changes or payments will be accepted via e-mail or phone. Registration link: **quivira.tentaroo.com** Registrations are not considered complete until payment is submitted. No registrations will be taken on site. Parts A & B of the health forms must be turned in for all participants at check in.
- Insurance?** Liability, as well as Sickness and Accident Insurance are provided for all registered youth and adult members of the Quivira Council.
