



2019 Webelos Woods @ Camp Kanza

October 18 – 20, 2019

- What is it?** A weekend camping adventure for first and second-year Webelos, designed to introduce important Scout skills in a fun environment. WW@CK is held annually at Camp Kanza and is staffed by outstanding local Troops from several Districts. Your Webelos will learn hands-on Scouting skills from older Scouts as they prepare to crossover to Troops.
- Activities?** On Saturday, Webelos will develop great knot-tying skills, learn all about pioneering and first aid, take aim at the range with BB guns and slingshots, try their hand at whittling, and camp out in Camp Kanza's natural habitat. On Sunday, we plan to have some exciting rescue scenarios and special guests.
- When & Where?** **Friday, October 18 – Sunday, October 20, 2019.** Check in will begin at 5:00 p.m. on Friday night for those that want to come out early. Saturday check in begins at 7:00 am. Program begins with a flag ceremony at 8:30 am. Camp Kanza is located near Abbyville, KS, just 20 miles west of Hutchinson.
- Supervision?** All units must have two-deep leadership and comply with Youth Protection guidelines, including having at least one Youth Protection trained adult.
- Cost?** **Early Bird Fee is \$16 per youth and \$13.50 per adult if paid by September 27.** Units are responsible for their own meals, but registration fee includes the Saturday evening cracker-barrel. All participants will receive a patch. Fees increase by \$5 per person after September 27, 2019.
- Refunds?** Refunds are not available, but fees are transferable to another Scout or Adult attending this event if done in advance of the event. This is a rain or shine event. Please see the Planning Guide for more details.
- Registration?** **Pre-registration is required** in order for us to provide program materials to all participants. This event is open to **ALL Webelos**. Please use *Tentaroo and register on-line. **Any registrations PAID after September 27 will not be guaranteed a patch.** Last day to register online is October 14.
- Insurance?** Liability, as well as Sickness and Accident Insurance are provided for all registered members of the Quivira Council. All attendees must be registered with BSA. No tag-along youth are permitted on Camp during this event.
