Cost? Registration **MUST** be received before September 28th, 2019.

 Early Bird (By Sept 21st) **\$5 per Scout and \$5 per Adult.**
 Regular Price (By Sept 28th) **\$7 per Scout and \$7 per Adult.**

ONLINE Pre-registration is required. NO ONSITE registration accepted.
Everyone must register as a Unit. NO Individual Registrations.
***Please use your Unit's Tentaroo account that has pre-filled rosters.**

EVENT IS LIMITED TO 400 YOUTH!!! Event is open to all Lion, Tiger, Wolf, and Bear Scouts. Pre-registration is required in order for us to provide program materials to all youth participants.
