

Quivira Council Eagle Scout Rank

Advancement Guide

Introduction:

The following overview is **provided as a guide** for service project approval and Eagle Advancement in the Pawnee District of the Quivira Council, BSA.

Eagle Scout Service Project:

After attaining the rank of Life, the scout may pursue an Eagle Scout service project.

- The project must benefit an organization other than Boy Scouting
- You must use the BSA form 512-927. The form can be found at www.scouting.org.
- A project proposal must be approved by the organization benefiting from the effort, your unit leader, unit committee, and the Pawnee District Advancement Committee before you start. No fundraising can be done before approval. The District Advancement Committee approval must be the last signature before you begin your project.
- The Scout needs to contact the District Advancement Chairman for project approval; normally the chairman or member of the district advancement committee will be available at the Monthly Pawnee District Roundtable Meeting.

Preparing for the Eagle Scout Rank:

The requirements for the rank of Eagle are contained in the Boy Scout Handbook, occasionally these are updated - take time to ensure you are working to the latest advancement requirements.

- It is the unit responsibility to ensure the latest requirements are reflected in the Eagle Scout Rank advancement application is used.
- If there are any questions concerning requirements or advancement policy's or procedures call the District Advancement Chair for assistance.

Getting ready for your board of review:

- The Eagle Scout Rank application (BSA form 512-728) has been reviewed by the Quivira Council Registrar and approved, the BOR cannot be scheduled until council has approved application and same returned to Scout with all required signatures
- You have completed a statement of ambitions
- Eagle Scout Service Project is complete, including all signatures
- Letters of reference were mailed out, and returned in sealed envelopes to your scoutmaster
- Your Eagle Rank Scoutmaster Conference is complete – and the signature is in your book

Eagle Scout Board of Review

- Be prepared to recite; Scout Oath, Law, Motto, Slogan, and discuss your project; Merit Badges; camping; etc.
- The Eagle BOR is typically conducted at the scout's unit. The unit scoutmaster or advancement chair should call the District Advancement Chair to arrange an Eagle BOR. The District Advancement Chair or a member of the District Advancement Committee will then take the lead to arrange a mutually agreeable time for the BOR.

Items for your Eagle Board of Review:

- Eagle Scout Rank Application (2 copies optional)
- Eagle Scout Service Project Workbook & Boy Scout Handbook
- Statement of Ambitions
- The Scoutmaster should have the sealed letters of reference, and an advancement form
- Appropriate and complete uniform – clean and in good repair all patches and rank emblems are correct
- The Eagle Board will need adequate time to review the documents before the Board of review – plan accordingly

After the BOR is complete the District Advancement Representative will sign the Eagle Scout rank application form and rank advancement form. It is the scout unit's responsibility to forward the signed advancement forms to the, Quivira Council Service Representative. You can contact her at 316-264-3386 or email beth.mills@scouting.org
