# RULES...

- No monetary trades
- Trades between adults and youth are strictly prohibited
- Disputes between traders are void
- Tabletop gaming, comics and Scouting related items only.
- No firearms, electronics, or especially valuable items are permitted in trade.

**Collectible/Valuables:** Do not put anything in the game vault for others to play that is considered collectible, rare, or valuable. By putting a game in the vault, you are loaning it to a fellow Scout. Treat his/her property like your own. Be good to each person's game!

## Tournaments:

- Scouts are expected to have excellent sportsmanship and win or lose gracefully.
- Tournaments will be designated as youth only or adult only as necessary.
- Players will be designated as 1-5, with 5 being skill level expert. Players will self-profess his/her skill level. Tournaments will be based on skills levels. Learning tournaments will be adult and youth mixed only for learning purposes. Skill level 5 will not be able to compete against skill levels 1-3 in any tournament.
- Tournaments winners are determined through fair play adjudicated by the game judge. Game judges word is final. Players can be disqualified for unsportsmanlike like conduct, no matter his/her game performance.

**Costume Contest:** No actual firearms. Weapons for cosplay must be clearly manufactured costume work. Costumes must be PG-13 and represent game/story lore. Youth class and Adult class competition.

**Dutch oven contest:** Judges' words are final. Food will be judged for quality of flavor and texture, ease of preparation, cost to produce. Adults may compete against youth.
