- What / Who?** This one and one-half day course is designed as an introduction to the Cub Scout outdoor program for those leaders (Cubmasters, Ass't. Cubmasters, Den leaders, other pack leaders, and parents) who are interested in adding a camping component to their Pack activities. **BALOO** is an instructor-led course that is conducted at the Council level. BSA's Cub Scout level camping policies will be taught along with the necessary tools to help units carry out a successful camping experience.
- Why?** Completion of this course is mandatory for at least one adult on a Pack overnighiter.
- When/Where?** Friday-Saturday, April 24-25 - 1400 N Main McPherson, KS. The weekend will begin with a 5:00 pm Check-In Friday evening with the class beginning promptly at 6:00 pm. We plan to conclude by 6:00 PM Saturday.
- Cost?** **\$20** per person. Refunds are not available but may be transferred to another leader. Saturday lunch will be provided.
- Registration?** **The deadline** to reserve a seat for the class will be **5:00 PM Wed. April 15, 2020.** Registration is online only.
