When & Where? The Camporee will be held on the west side of Lake Afton again this year. Official check in will begin at 5:30 pm on Friday April 17th, but camping spots are available on a first come, first serve basis prior to check-in. Any campsite reserved or used prior to Friday April 17 will have to pay the normal camping fees of Lake Afton. Activities will begin on Saturday morning at 8:30am.

Supervision?

All units must have two-deep leadership in accordance with Youth Protection Guidelines, and all registered leaders must have completed NEW Youth Protection Training.

Cost?

Registration Fees are \$10 per Scout / \$7.50 per Adult.

LATE registrations must take place at Camporee check-in. Late fees of \$13 per Scout/ \$10.50 per adult may be paid with Check or Cash – NO credit/debit cards will be accepted!

Last day to register online is Fri., April 10, 2020

Refunds?

Refunds are not available, but fees may be transferred to another Scout or Adult.

Registration?

Pre-registration is required in order for program materials and patches to be provided to all participants. **Registration prior to April 8th is required to guarantee a patch.** Event is open to all registered Troops, Crews and Posts. **Online payment is required** and may be made by credit card or electronic check.
