- What is it?** Day of Awesomeness provides our cubbies with the opportunity to be immediately active and engaged in Cub Scout programming!! Cub Scouts will enjoy a day of non-stop fun with their friends. Boy Scouts of America Quivira Council will provide Scouting activities typically offered at summer camp, but right in their own back yards, *almost!*
- Activities?** Archery, Obstacle Course, BB Guns, Pinewood Derby cars, Knot tying, Sling Shots, etc. Lunch is not provided; snacks available at concession stand
- When & Where?** Saturday, October 3, 2020 9:00AM-2:30PM

- Check-In:** 8:30AM —After parking at Rainbows, locate the table with the first letter of your child’s last name; you’ll be directed where to go from there
- Supervision?** Packs must have two-deep leadership in accordance with Youth Protection Guidelines and **ALL ADULTS** must have completed the **NEW** Youth Protection Training
ALL Lions (Kindergarten) & Tigers (1st Grade) are required to have a registered Adult Partner present with them for the activities. Event is open to all Lion, Tiger, Wolf, and Bear Scouts.
- Cost?** \$5 per Youth and \$5 per Adult. Registration **MUST** be received before September 26th, 2020. Pre-registration is required; registrations accepted after 9/26.

ONLINE Pre-registration is required. NO ONSITE registration accepted.
