

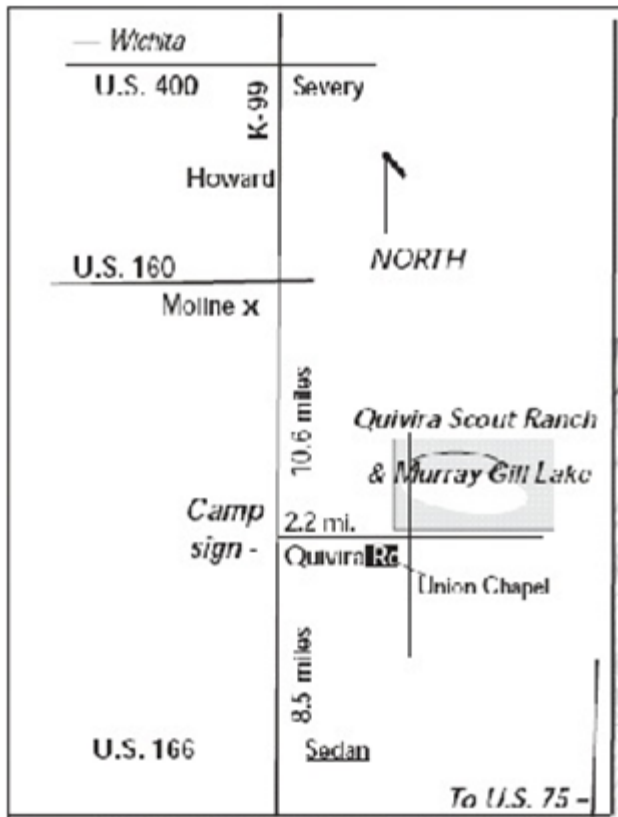
# 2020 Webelos Woods

- What is it? A weekend camping adventure for Webelos and Arrow of Lights, designed to introduce important Scout skills in a fun environment. WW is held annually and is staffed by outstanding local Troops from several Districts. Your Webelos and AOLs will learn hands-on Scouting skills from older Scouts as they prepare to crossover to Troops.
- Activities? Scouts will develop great knot-tying skills, learn all about outdoor Scout skills, take aim at the range with BB guns and slingshots, try their hand at whittling, camp out under the stars, and much more!
- When & Where? **Friday, October 16 - Sunday, October 18, 2020 @ Quivira Scout Ranch (note location change!)** Check in will begin at 5:00 p.m. on Friday night for those that want to come out early. Saturday check in begins at 7:00 am. Program begins at 8:30 am. Please be aware, EVERY PERSON MUST have a Quivira Council Covid-19 Waiver form, found in the leader guide, turned in with their unit's check in packet at the event.
- Registration? ***Given the evolving issues with COVID, we may need to limit attendance this year, so we encourage early registration to ensure a spot in the event. Pre-registration is required*** in order for us to provide program materials to all participants. This event is currently open to ALL Webelos & AOLs. Please use Black Pug and register on-line. Last day to register online is Monday, October 12. ***Any registrations PAID after September 25 will not be guaranteed a patch.***
- Supervision? **All** units must have two-deep leadership and comply with Youth Protection guidelines. **All** adults must be registered with BSA with current YPT. Current national membership will be verified. *We will be sharing additional information on youth to adult program participant ratios as we get closer to the event.*
- Cost? **Early Bird Fee is \$16 per youth and \$13.50 per adult if paid by September 25.** Units are responsible for their own meals, but registration fee includes the Saturday evening cracker-barrel. All participants will receive a patch and a carabiner. Fees increase by \$5 per person after September 25, 2019.
- Refunds? Refunds are not available, but fees are transferable to another Scout or Adult attending this event if done in advance of the event. This is a rain or shine event. Please see the Leaders Planning Guide for more details.
- Insurance? Liability, as well as Sickness and Accident Insurance are provided for all registered members of the Quivira Council. **All** attendees must be registered with BSA. **Absolutely NO** tag-along, youth OR adult, are permitted on Camp during this event.

## GETTING TO QSR

The Quivira Scout Ranch is about a two-hour drive from Wichita, in Chautauqua County in southeastern Kansas. The Ranch is located 8.5 miles north of Sedan, KS on highway K-99.

Take highway 54/U.S. 400 east to K-99. Take K-99 south to Quivira Rd, a gravel road, the Camp sign is on the west side of 99 and turn east for 2.2 miles to camp entrance.

**OR**

Take U.S. 160 to K-99 and travel south from Moline, KS 10.6 miles to the county road. Turn east for 2.2 miles to camp entrance.
