Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation Specifics Training

at the Quivira Council Service Center

What / Who?

This one and one-half day course is designed as an introduction to the Cub Scout outdoor program for those leaders (Cubmasters, Asst. Cubmasters, Den leaders, other pack leaders, and parents) who are interested in adding a camping component to their Pack activities. **BALOO** is an instructor-led course which is conducted at the Council level. BSA's Cub Scout level camping policies will be taught along with the necessary tools to help units carry out a successful camping experience.

Why?

Completion of this course is mandatory for at least one adult on a Pack overnigher.

When/Where?

Saturday-Sunday, October 10-11 - Quivira Council Service Center. 3247 N Oliver
The day will begin with a 7:30am Check-In Saturday morning. Class begins promptly at 8:30am. We plan to conclude by 11:00 AM Sunday morning.

Cost?

Early Bird Registration (**through September 25th**) is **\$25** per participant.
LATE Registration increases to **\$30** per participant **on September 26th**.
Refunds are not available, but may be transferred to another leader.
ALL Meals will be provided.
