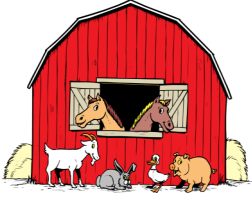


Down on the Farm Day Camp 2021

July 14, 15, 16, 2021



Your health and safety is our utmost concern. For that reason, we will be taking Covid-19 precautions during camp. Precautions include: all persons entering camp will receive temperature checks at registration; all staff will be screened and have temperatures taken daily; all equipment will be sanitized intermittently; hand sanitizer will be provided for all participants and staff. Campers and staff must wear masks during activities unless local ordinances lift the mask ordinance in July. Extra masks will be provided for any attendees who forget to bring one. - What is it?** *Down on the Farm Day Camp* is a fun-filled, **THREE DAY** camp for Cub Scouts of ALL ages! Each day will provide the opportunity for your Scouts to have new experiences, with memories that will last a lifetime.
- When** **Wednesday, Thursday & Friday, July 14-15-16, 2021.** Registration starts at 8:30am.
Opening Flag at 9:00am. Programs run 9:15am to 4:00pm each day. Please pick up your Camper by no later than 4:00pm each day. This Camp does not include overnight camping stay.
- Where?** **Lake Afton**, 24600 W. 39th St. S. Goddard, KS 67052 Check in will begin at 8:30am each day of camp. Camp runs until 4:00pm each day. If the case of inclement weather, we will continue with camp in a building.
- Activities?** All activities are age appropriate and based on program level, including BB Guns, Archery, Wrist Rockets, Fishing, Swimming, Arts & Crafts, Games, Farming Education, etc. **Each person will need to pack a Sack Lunch each day.**
- Supervision?** All registered packs **MUST** have an adult in attendance! See below for Adult/Child ratio guidelines:
-Scout ratio of 1/5 and be 2 deep in leadership in accordance with Youth Protection Guidelines
-ALL adults must have completed Youth Protection Training prior to camp
-Please provide a copy of all Adult Youth Protection Certifications at check-in the 1st day
-ALL Tigers must have parent partner with them (one parent per Tiger). **No Tag Alongs (younger siblings) allowed.**
- Registration?** **EVENT IS LIMITED TO 120 SCOUTS!!!** Event is open to Cub Scouts, Tigers through Arrows of Light, in or out of Council. Pre-registration is required in order for us to provide patches, cups, shirts and program materials to all youth participants as well as patches/shirts to registered adults. Registration is due July 7, 2021.
- Fees?** Registrations received *prior to July 1st* will be **\$45.00 per youth and \$20.00 per adult**. ALL registrations received *after July 1st* will register at the regular rate of **\$55.00 per youth and \$30.00 per adult**. **NO registrations will be accepted after July 7th** or at Camp! **Multi-youth family discount- \$25.00 per youth, Adult \$20.00**. It will be verified that they live at the same address. **Multi-youth late fee will be applied after July 1st to \$40.00 per youth and \$25.00 per adult.** **EVENT IS LIMITED TO 120 SCOUTS!!!** Event is open to all Cub Scouts—Tiger's thru Arrow of Light Scouts for all packs, in or out of Council. **Pre-registration BY WED., JUNE 23 is required** in order for us to provide patches, cups, shirts and program materials to all youth participants as well as patches and shirts to registered adults.
Registration is online only! The registration link can be found at <https://quivira.org/camping-with-quivira/> webpage. Once on Black Pug registration software, scroll the calendar of current events to find the Day Camp for which you wish to register: *Down on the Farm Day Camp 2021*. Online payment is required & can be made by credit card or electronic check.
- Health Forms?** Parts A & B health forms, & the PARENTAL/ GUARDIAN, SCOUT, & LEADER COVID-19 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT & CONSENT WAIVER FORM, must be provided for all participants at check in. We will NOT have health forms provided on site. Any person without a completed health form will not be allowed to take part in the event. Any persons not registered for the event will not be allowed to attend the event & will be asked to leave. **All Adults must have taken Youth Protection online, too.** This is more for the safety and well-being of all youth in attendance at Camp.
- Refunds?** There will be NO Refunds available, but you can transfer to another Scout.
- Insurance?** Liability, Sickness and Accident Insurance is provided for all registered youth & adult members of Quivira Council.
