



## ***Webelos Woods 2021 @ Harvey County West Park***

- What is it?** This camping adventure is for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year Webelos. It is held annually and is staffed by some of the top Scout BSATroops from several Districts. Webelos Scouts will be introduced to several Scouting skills along with just plain old fun activities. They will interact with Scouts BSA youth to help prepare them for their own cross-over.
- Activities?** This year's event will include Fire Building / Woods Tools; First Aid Skills; Camp Cooking; Camp Gadget Building; Wilderness/Weather Survival; and Team Building Activities.
- When & Where?** **Saturday October 16<sup>th</sup> – Sunday October 17<sup>th</sup>.** Check in will begin at 7:00 am on Saturday morning. Program begins with a flag ceremony at 8:30 am. Webelos Woods will be held at Harvey County West Park near Halstead KS, Just West of Newton.
- Supervision?** All units must have two-deep leadership in accordance with Youth Protection guidelines. Adults must be Youth Protection Trained.
- Cost?** Early Bird Fee's - **\$16 per youth and \$12.50 per adult. if paid by October 1<sup>st</sup>.** Participants registered by Oct 1<sup>st</sup> will receive a patch. Fees increase by \$5 per person (Y or A) after Oct 1, 2021.
- NOTE:** **This year we are asking that each participant, youth and adult, bring at least one non-perishable canned food item for the Reno County Food bank. Help us deliver over 700 items.** Turn in will be at the Saturday morning Flag Ceremony.
- Refunds?** Refunds are not available, but fees are transferable to another Scout or Adult. This is a rain or shine event.
- Registration?** **Pre-registration is required** for us to provide program materials to all participants. Event is open to **ALL Quivira Council Webelos/AOL Scouts.** Please register via Black Pug. Blackpug via the Quivira.org web site.
- Tag Along(s)?** **No tag-along** youth are permitted on Camp during this event.
- Insurance?** Liability, as well as Sickness and Accident Insurance are provided for all registered members of the Quivira Council.
- Covid Notice:** Council Covid forms are required to attend this event. Each leader is responsible to ensure that no scout or adult from their unit is showing Covid symptom's prior to or during this event. Any individual exhibiting symptoms of Covid will be asked to leave camp immediately as well as the entire unit. These are the same guidelines as were used at summer camp.

### **Check-In**

#### **Process:**

When you enter camp, the Unit Leader will be asked to provide:

- (1) Copy of Black Pug PAID Receipt
- (2) Copy of a Unit Roster listing each attendee (A&Y)
- (3) Copies of signed Council Covid forms for each attendee
- (4) BSA Health Form with Part's A & B for each person attending
