As a current or potential District/Council/Unit trainer, we are pleased to invite you to participate in the **“Trainer’s EDGE™”** Course!

What is it? The **“Trainer’s EDGE™”** is suggested for all BSA Trainers (and those interested in training) in our Council and is a required course for Wood Badge and National Youth Leadership Training staff. The purpose of the **“Trainer’s EDGE™”** course is to provide and help develop the platform skills of a trainer and is meant to supplement the practice that is offered through Wood Badge, NYLT, and other staff developments. You will have the opportunity to give several presentations during the day.

***Pre-course Preparation:** As part of the learning process, each participant will give a 10 to 12-minute presentation on a Scout-related topic of his or her choosing from the Scout BSA Handbook or another program element like Cub Scouting or Venturing. Participants may use any media they choose, and they should bring any material or equipment they need for their presentation with them to the **“Trainer’s EDGE™”** Course (i.e. laptop, flipchart, etc.). Presentations will be conducted in a team setting via Zoom. The presentation may be a specific skills session that uses the **“EDGE™”** (Explain, Demonstrate, Guide, Enable) method, but the broader skills of the trainer should also be demonstrated. A broad topic choice, such as presenting training information about the uniform, advancement, high adventure, hiking, or camping, could be selected. **You have homework!**
